You may have read in the local newspapers about the pre-registration for the Pennsylvania REAL ID that we will all be required to have. Penn Dot in conjunction with Rep. Kurt Masser will hold a registration here at Holy Rosary Parish Social Hall on **February 13<sup>th</sup>**, 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. This is a great opportunity for our parish and the community! More information will follow regarding what documents you will need to provide. This event allows you to sit in comfort and enjoy a hot beverage instead of standing in line at the local DOT office. Thank you to Rep. Masser for working with us to make this event happen.

*The federal REAL ID law established guidelines for states to provide new and more secure forms of identification cards. Residents will need these new REAL ID cards in the future in order to enter federal buildings, including courthouses, as well as to board commercial flights. Residents who would like to pre-qualify for a REAL ID at this event should bring with them original versions or certified copies of the necessary documents.*

*Applicants must bring proof of their identity in the form of an original or certified copy of their birth certificate with a raised or embossed seal, or a valid U.S. passport or passport card. Birth certificates with a sticker rather than an embossed seal will not be accepted. "Our office can help residents if they need to try to obtain their original birth certificate," Rep. Masser said.*

*Applicants must bring their Social Security card, which cannot be laminated or sealed in plastic, and the name on this card must match the name on the person's current driver license or photo identification card.*

*Applicants must bring proof of all legal name changes, including marriage certificates or court orders issued by a family court. Applicants must have documentation to show all name changes from their original name on their birth certificate to their current name.*

*Applicants finally must also bring two forms of proof of their current physical, Pennsylvania address, which could include an expired Pennsylvania driver's license or photo identification card, or a bank statement or utility bill that is no more than 90 days old and shows the individual's name and address.*
