Pastor's Advisory Council Minutes

April 12, 2010

A meeting of the Pastor's Advisory Council was held on Monday, April 12, 2010 with the following members in attendance: Ann Benedict, Tom Bradley, Marian Chesney, Anna Deane, John Feudale, Jan Kanaskie, Stephen Major, Brenda Roadarmel, Sue Singh, Ed Valeyko, and Helen Vought. Father Al thanked everyone for attending and the meeting opened with a prayer.

- 1.** The March minutes were reviewed and approved with no omissions or corrections. Anna Deane made a motion to approve the minutes and Marian Chesney made a motion to second that approval.

2. Update on Parish Center

Father Al reported that we have received all keys and can now officially occupy the building. The elevator certification check has been completed. Father Chester Snyder will have a Prayer Service on the Book of Blessings during the Dedication at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 16. He will bless each room and then move into the social hall. Our Council of Catholic Women will provide refreshments and the social. The Architect, Superintendent, as well as local priests and sisters will be sent formal invitations. The Finance Committee, Pastor's Advisory Council, Steering Committee, Building Committee, and CCD teachers will also be invited to attend. Craig Hensler, our maintenance man has been working diligently getting things set up and floors cleaned. Blackboards, bulletin boards, clocks, and crucifix's are in the process of being hung in each room.

3. Issues for Discussion

- A.** The paving that will cost \$22,000 (this price went down from the price quoted in the fall) will be completed prior to the dedication.
- B.** Father passed out information on the After-School Care Program.
- C.** Our part-time maintenance person, Craig Hensler, is working out quite well. He is a self starter and initiates things. Father Al increased his work hours from 20 to 25 hours/week.
- D.** Fr. Bill Haviland will be coming in June. As a retired priest, he will help with Masses only or whatever he wishes.

4. Old Business/New Business

- A.** The light bulb is fixed at the rear of the social hall.

- B. River rock will be placed between the new sidewalk and the building.
- C. Zimmerman's Electric is connecting the security system between all buildings.
- D. The 13 Week Social Club Big Party will be held Sunday, April 25th.
- E. Carol retires May 21st. A reception in her honor will be held Saturday evening May 1, after the 5:00 p.m. Mass. Brenda Roadarmel, Jan Kanaskie, Beth Bembenek and John Feudale are planning for this occasion.
- E. Four candidates were interviewed for the full-time position of Secretary/Bookkeeper, and the applicant chosen will begin on May 10th for a two- week training period.
- F. As of today we only have one volunteer for our Nursery to be held during Masses. A Children's Liturgy of the Word Program will be started with the children being dismissed early from Mass to receive the Gospel and Readings.
- G. Elections for the Pastor's Advisory Council will be held in the near future. A Nominating Committee has been set up consisting of Father Al, Jan Kanaskie, Anna Deane, and Joe Yale. An article will be placed into the parish bulletin. The new members will begin their term/s at the September meeting.

5. Next Meeting

The next meeting will be held Tuesday, May 18, at 6:30 p.m. at the rectory along with the Finance Committee including all spouses for drinks and hors' d'erves.
